The temperatures on this trip will vary depending on elevation, but will generally range from 90 for a high to 40 for a low. We will spend a fair amount of time driving on this 2,400 mile trip. I will have education workbooks that I have made, as well as a library of other books for those who can read in the car. Most of our drive is not on curvy roads. There will also be the opportunity to get Jr. Ranger badges at the National parks and I will have those books as well. There will be opportunities to purchase items from Visitor Center gift shops along the way if you want to bring money for souvenirs. The itinerary is busy. The camp chores will be a community venture in order to provide more fun time for all. We have gear we can loan you – just ask in advance please.
